Handling Procedures of Students' Early Leave (School Circular No.194 (22-23))

Early leave for personal reasons (e.g. medical appointment, examination):

- 1. Written application should be made at least 3 school days prior to the day of early leave. Class teachers will contact parents for confirmation. Upon approval, students should be picked up by parents in person.
- 2. If parents are unable to pick up their children in person,
 - a. Students are advised to take a half-day or a full-day leave.
 - b. Arrange a relative aged over 18 to pick up the child. The name of the relative should be stated on the written application. The school will contact the parents and record the name and ID number of the relative upon his/her arrival.
 - c. Arrange with the Principal, Vice Principal and the Discipline Mistress for regular leaves (e.g. for regular medical reviews).

Early leave for emergency reasons:

- 1. Before leaving school, students have to inform the general office, the class teacher will contact the parents for confirmation. If the class teacher cannot contact the parents due to any ongoing job duty or other reasons, staff of the school general office will be authorized by the Principal or the Vice Principal to contact the parents.
- 2. All the related documents have to be signed before the student leaves the school.

The Household Application for Student Financial Assistance Schemes for the 2023/24 school year will start accepting applications soon. Needy families may submit applications to the Student Finance Office (SFO) of the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency to apply for student financial assistance for students at pre-primary, primary or secondary levels.

SFO encourages applicants to <u>apply online</u>. Applicants <u>applying online</u> will receive subsidy earlier than those using paper-based application forms. Continuing applicants who have submitted the completed application and supporting documents online on or before 31 May 2023, met the relevant eligibility criteria and passed the mean test will receive the provisional School Textbook Assistance and Subsidy for Internet Access Charges (if applicable) from around mid-July 2023. In addition, using E-form is convenient and saves time. Applicants may complete and submit applications online with their personal computers or smart phones and upload supporting documents online anytime and anywhere. Applicants no longer need to submit applications in person or by post, and this can also save money on postage and photocopying.

New applicants may access the E-link on or after 2 May 2023 to use the E-form and submit online.

¹ If continuing applicants has indicated in their 2022/23 household application that they need paper-based application form for the next school year, apart from issuing to them a paper-based form for the 2023/24 School Year pre-filled with the applicant's basic information, SFO will also issue to them an access code for making online application.
