Objectives:

- Aims of the Outdoor Study Trip: Outdoor Study Trip is part of our school education. It enhances classroom learning by providing opportunities for pleasurable learning in a natural environment. As the Outdoor Study Trip is considered a formal school activity, all students should behave well as usual.
- The details of the meeting places of those classes having activities outside school will be informed by class teachers later.

Remark:

- 1. All students must arrive on time through the school entrance of <u>Po Fung Road</u> (near the Metro City).
- 2. The school will be open at 7:30 am on that day.
- 3. As the Outdoor Study Trip is considered to be a formal school activity for the whole school, <u>all</u> <u>students are required to attend.</u> Students who are not able to join the activities must submit a parent letter to the Principal through their class teachers 3 days prior to the day of the activity. If students take sick leave on that day, medical certificates should be submitted to the class teachers upon resumption of school, or playing truant will be regarded.
- 4. All students have to wear proper PE uniforms.
- 5. Students with improper dressing or discipline problems will be arranged to stay at the school and regarded as a violation of discipline.
- 6. Students are encouraged to practice green living. To reduce the disposal of disposable items and reduce pollution, students should bring their own water bottles, hand towels, environment-friendly lunch boxes and tableware.

Guidance notes for the activity:

- 1. Students are educated to love and preserve our earth and public properties. They should handle rubbish properly.
- 2. Students must arrive at the designated gathering venue punctually.
- 3. Bring along the student card and ID Card.
- 4. Students should take care of their own belongings and they should not bring too much money.

- 5. Do not meet friends outside school at the venues.
- 6. Students should not leave the group. In case of emergency, they should report to the teachers promptly.
- 7. Students should follow the safety guidelines and the instructions given by teachers.
- 8. At the end of the activity, all students should return to the designated venue and take attendance before dismissal.
- 9. Further information will be announced by class teachers.

Emergency response measures:

- 1. If there is an announcement concerning suspension of classes due to bad weather before 6:30a.m., the Outdoor Study Trip for all forms will be cancelled, students are not required to go to school.
- 2. If a red/black rainstorm warning is issued, Typhoon Signal No.1 or above is hoisted or when the AQHI reaches "Serious" level (band 10+) before 6:30a.m., the Outdoor Study Trip for all forms will be cancelled, students are not required to go to school.
- 3. According to the Guidelines on Outdoor Activities, students with heart, respiratory or chronic illnesses are not suitable for engaging in outdoor activities when the AQHI reaches "Very high" level or above (band 8-10 or above), those students should stay in the school to do revision.
