● Promotion Standards (School Circular No.253 (25-26))

The following are the promotion criteria for each form:

Promotion	Criteria
F.1 to F.2	Average mark must be 50 or above; Conduct grade must be C- or above.
F.2 to F.3	
F.3 to F.4	
F.4 to F.5*	Average mark must be 40 or above;
F.5 to F.6*	Pass in Chinese, English, Mathematics, Citizenship and Social Development and one elective subject to be taken in HKDSE (40 marks or above, not including applied learning subjects); Conduct grade must be C- or above. (*Repeaters may not be able to take their original elective subjects.)

For students who cannot meet the above standards, the school may consider the students' academic results, discipline committee's comments, the number of students and the combination of subjects in deciding the promotion. For students who are diagnosed (by a social worker and EDB's representatives) to have learning difficulties, special examination arrangement will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

● F.1 to F.5 Second Term Test (School Circular No.254 (25-26))

The Second Term Test for Form 1 to Form 5 students will be held from 23rd to 27th March 2026. Please see the attached document for details. **Students can go home and do revision after the test. No lesson will be held in the afternoon. Form 4 and Form 5 students who do not have to sit the second session test can also go home after the first session.** In case school must be cancelled due to deteriorating weather conditions, the test(s) scheduled on that day will be cancelled and postponed to a later date while other tests that followed will be preceded as scheduled.

● F.6 students access to HKDSE personal data (School Circular No.256 (25-26))

In order to collect Hong Kong Secondary School Examination scoring records and copies of examination papers for the school's teaching purposes, the school now invites Form 6 students to assist in 'Personal Data Request' (checking papers). The application form, authorization letter and consent form will be distributed on 4-6 March. Students should complete and sign them before 6 March, and a photocopy of the ID card should be submitted to the class teacher at that time. All application fees will be borne by the school.

After the HKDSE results are released, we will notify students individually regarding the subjects to be checked. After receiving copies of the scoring records and examination papers, they will be copied and archived, and all information will be returned to the students. All photocopies of students' ID cards will be destroyed on 30 November.
